July 2023

Alumni Email Platform

In July 2023, BUHSC Student Support Centre (SSC) launched a dedicated alumni email platform to enhance communication with the alumni network. This initiative marks a significant step in fostering stronger connections and facilitating alumni affairs.

A separate alumni email was created to streamline communication between BU and its alumni.

September 2023

Issuance of Alumni Cards
